

**BOIL WATER NOTICE RESCINDED**  
**August 29, 2017**

On August 26, 2017, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality required the City of Livingston public water system, to issue a Boil Water Notice to inform customers, individuals, or employees that due to conditions which occurred recently, the water from this public water system was required to be boiled prior to use for drinking water or human consumption purposes.

The City of Livingston has taken the necessary corrective actions to restore the quality of the water distributed by their public water system used for drinking water or human consumption purposes and has provided TCEQ with laboratory test results that indicate that the water no longer requires boiling prior to use as of August 29, 2017.
